NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS FOR THE
LIQUID ORGANIC WASTE RECEIVING AND BIOGAS TREATMENT UPGRADES PROJECT
CMSA CONTRACT NO. 23-01 ("Project")

The Project includes furnishing all labor, materials and equipment to install a new above grade receiving tank for liquid organic wastes; providing associated site improvements including tank foundation, equipment pads, curbs, drainage, grading, and site lighting; installing owner-furnished screening system and pressure washer; furnishing and installing a new mixing pump, valves and piping; and providing all civil, mechanical, structural, electrical, and instrumentation and controls work and appurtenances as shown in the plans and specifications to integrate the new tank into the Agency's existing Organic Waste Receiving Facility (OWRF). The Contract also includes modifications to the existing biogas treatment system, which includes removing the existing fuel gas dryer and replacing with new redundant chillers and a heat exchanger; constructing a retaining wall, drainage ditch, and concrete pad; and performing all associated work and appurtenances as shown in the plans and specifications.

The estimated cost of construction is \$1,714,000. A valid Class A California contractor's license is required to bid on the Project. Sealed bids must be delivered to the Central Marin Sanitation Agency ("CMSA"), 1301 Andersen Drive, San Rafael, California on or before **2:00 PM on Tuesday September 27, 2022 (Pacific Time)**. At that time the bids will be publicly opened and read.

An optional pre-bid conference will be held via a virtual video conferencing platform at 10:00 AM (Pacific Time) on Wednesday September 7, 2022. Contact CMSA Associate Engineer Joyce Cheung at jcheung@cmsa.us for a link to the virtual conference at least 24 hours before the start of the pre-bid conference. A site visit may be conducted by the Contractor at its convenience prior to the preparation of its bid if the Owner is notified at least 24 hours in advance.
